

March 25, 2020 | State of Idaho Stay-At-Home Order

Earlier today, Idaho Governor Brad Little issued a statewide stay-at-home proclamation as COVID-19 continues to spread. Gov. Little announced the order will remain in effect for 21 days.

Additionally, the Idaho North Central District and the Emergency Management Coordinator for Nez Perce County, have issued a Public Health Emergency Order 20-01 for the City of Lewiston. This means that there shall be no gatherings in groups of more than 10 people.

In accordance with these measures, and as a non-essential business, the Lewiston Roundup Facility including the Indoor Arena, Outdoor Arena, and Ketch Pen are closed through April 15th. This will impact both reservations and facility use for renters and members.

Please note the following:

- Lewiston Roundup Riding Areas (Indoor Arena, Outdoor Arena, Sliding Track, Warm-Up Arena) are not open for use.
- Any rental deposits for reservations that are not used will be refunded at the end of the Stay-At-Home directive issued.
- Boarders are allowed access to the Lewiston Roundup grounds in order to care for animals housed on-site.
- Lewiston Roundup facilities are closed to riding members during this time.

This will also affect our Jennifer Casey Breakaway Clinic hosted by Lewiston Roundup on April 11 & 12. With the fluidity and ever-changing landscape we are navigating, all paid funds for this clinic will be refunded the same way that they were paid. Payments via Square may take 7-9 business days. The Lewiston Roundup Association will work with our clinician to review the possibility of rescheduling at a later date.

Any future changes or updates will be issued via LRA's website, and social media accounts.
